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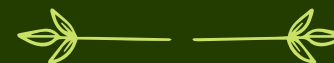

From economic importance to aesthetics, the reasons for conserving wetlands have become numerous over the past few decades.

The main objective of the conference is to provide a platform for academicians, scientists, researchers, professionals and students to present and discuss their research work and innovational outcomes in the field of biodiversity and wetland conservation. The conference will also associate several outstanding scientists from different parts of India for sharing their findings with young researchers and to establish relationship with each other for future collaborations. • How to reach Arjuni Morgaon

It is about 130 km from the city of Nagpur and 80 km from the district headquarters of Gondia. The Maharashtra state road transport corporation runs buses and private buses connecting Arjuni Morgaon to Nagpur, Gadchiroli and Gondia. Arjuni Morgaon railway station connects to Gondia-Ballarshah electric BG line with stoppage of all types of express and passenger trains. The nearest airport is Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar International Airport Nagpur is about 130 km from Arjuni Morgaon.

• Accommodation

Accommodation can be arranged for outstation participants in the guest house if informed well in advance.

• Field visit

The field visit would initiate at 06.00 am on 25th February 2023 to selected wetlands for bird watching on first come first serve basis with limited seats. The travel charges would be borne by the participants.
