



Admission Procedure

The admission process will be conducted as per the rules framed by the admission committee under the chairmanship of Principal.

The admission process framed by Admission committee is as under.

- 1) Online University registration by visiting Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University website / portal and take a printout.
- 2) Purchase Prospectus from the college.
- 3) Fill the admission form provided along with the prospectus accurately.
- 4) Online admission registration in the college and take a print of it.
- 5) Receipt of University registration, Admission form and print of online admission registration should be verified by admission committee.
- 6) For direct/spot admission, after verification of the documents by the admission committee, the admission form should be signed by Principal and admission will be confirmed by payment of necessary fee.
- 7) Merit List of students will be published.
- 8) The students seeking EBC/PTC/Scholarship/other concessions should submit the necessary relevant forms on or before the date declared by the Principal.
- 9) It is compulsory for all students taking admission in the college to fill University Student Insurance Fund form accurately.

The facilities of xeroxing, printing and all online registration is available in the college with cheaper rates. So, no need to pay extra outside.

- 8) Eligibility certificate (if necessary)

Admission Eligibility

- 1) Every student should ensure that he/she is eligible as per RTMNU,Nagpur University rules while taking admission. Admission to any class will remain the responsibility of the students.
- 2) If the student is ineligible for admission, his/her fee will not be refunded.
- 3) The last date of admission will be decided by the university and the government.
- 4) The Principal shall have full rights to admit or not to admit.

Special Notes

- 1) For Environment Course (B.A.-II, B.Com.-II, B.Sc.-II) Rs.100 /- Per student fee to pay.
- 2) Admission fee will not be charged at the time of admission from scholarship holders and freeship holders. Social Welfare Office, Gondia and Project Officer, Deori will deduct the remaining admission fee from the scholarship.
- 3) Students taking admission in RTM Nagpur University from other Boards / Universities will have to pay arrival fee of Rs.150/-. In case of rejection of tuition fees for EBC concession and scholarship students, students will have to pay the said fee.
- 4) If a student's form is rejected by the Zilla Parishad for any reason or the scholarship application is cancelled, he will have to pay the full fee immediately.
- 5) Failure to fill the nomination form will result in immediate cancellation of admission.
- In case of leaving the college midway, the student will have to pay the full fee. Without paying the full fee the student will not get any certificate.
- 7) Eligibility certificate must be obtained from RTM Nagpur University before taking admission in a college for the students from outside of Maharashtra Board of Education and other universities. A student can be admitted to the college only if the merit certificate is attached with the admit card.
- 8) Subjects once taken cannot be changed without permission of the Principal. Such permission can be obtained only keeping in mind the remaining seats and overall student trend and the students must take such a decision within one month after taking admission.

Removal from the college

The Principal reserves the right to remove the name of any student from the rolls for

- 1) Failure to pay college dues before the due date.
- 2) Failure to come up to academic standard.
- 3) Conduct, which in the opinion of the Principal, is unsatisfactory and objectionable.
- 4) Failure in attending 75% of the lectures during each term.
- 5) Furnishing false information and certificates.
- 6) If any student is found involve in ragging in the college premises.
- 7) violating the discipline, rules and regulations of the college after admission.

Scholarships and Other Concessions:

Scheduled Castes and Tribes, Other Backward Castes, Nomadic Castes and Freedom Struggle Children of soldiers are provided scholarships by the government. The government of India scholarship to the SC/ST/OBC/VJ/NT/SBC/Rajashri Shahu Maharaj Shikshan Shulk Shishyavrutti Scheme for open category students is granted on the basis of income. Every such students must have to open the accounts in Nationalized bank.

Scholarship will not be granted in the following cases.

- 1) For SC, ST students, the income of parent/guardian should not exceed Rs 2,50,000/- and for OBC, SBC, VJ/NT should not exceed Rs 1,50,000/-.
- 2) No account in Nationalized bank and Adhar card is not linked with it.
- 3) The students who completed any professional course.
- 4) The students having less than 75% attendance.

Procedure for submission of scholarship or concession form

For GOI scholarship

The students under the lower income group should apply online for GOI e-scholarship and Maharashtra state government scholarship in the prescribed form and submit hard copy in the college within a month after the admission. The student should be vigilant enough to fill the form completely in all respects as any omission or incorrect/false information may disqualify to get the GOI scholarship.

Along with Govt of India scholarship form attach attested copy of mark sheet, attested copy of previous school leaving certificate, caste certificate from Aadhaar card authorized executive magistrate, income proof, domicile certificate as well as previous year's basic salary, dearness allowance, house rent allowance, increased principal for those whose parents are employed. Certificate of full details regarding salary and other allowances if received etc. Income tax form of previous year.

The form must be signed by the student and the parent wherever necessary. Students coming from another district have to attach the district transfer certificate along with the scholarship form, which should be signed by the District Social Welfare Officer.

Free Studentship Education Concession

- 1) Free studentship to children of Primary / Secondary School Teachers.
- 2) Free studentship to DC students.

For Rajashri Shahu Maharaj Shikshan Shulk Shishyavrutti Scheme

For non-professional course, if the income is upto Rs 8,00,000/- student will get benefit of tution fees and examination fees (for govt course – 100%, for non-govt aided course – 100%, for partially aided course – 100%, for permanently unaided course – 100%)



Eligibility

- 1) Income certificate must be of less than Rs 8 lakh.
- 2) As per GR, only first two children are eligible.
- 3) Student should be domicile of Maharashtra.
- 4) Student should not avail any other scholarship or stipend.
- 5) Student should not have a gap of 2 years during his/her course duration.

Documents Required Income Certificate From Tahashildar.

- 1) Declaration certificate about 2 Children.
- 2) Domicile Certificate.
- 3) Attendance Certificate.
- 4) Receipt of Examination Fees.
- 5) Previous Year Marklist

Primary/Secondary school teachers ward concession

Children of all full time primary/secondary school teachers working in govt., local bodies and recognized and aided private primary/secondary school, etc. are eligible for concession of free studentship.

Eligibility

- 1) Regular attendance (not less than 75%).
- 2) Satisfactory progress and good conduct.
- 3) Parent of student should be resident of Maharashtra.
- 4) Application should be within 30 days.

Important Instructions

- 1. Fee Waiver Application and Income Proof Fee Waiver Application from parents having annual income less than Rs.1,00,000/- for E.B.C. Concession form in two copies must be submitted to the office within 15 days from the date of admission.
- 2. Disabled students should make proper inquiry in the office whether they are eligible for any scholarship or concession or not. Special notice to students who get discount and scholarship The scholarship of such students will be deducted if they are absent without permission for more than the number of days sanctioned as per the government norms. If the student's unsatisfactory progress in college examination E.B.C. Concession or scholarship may be denied.
- 3. The scholarship application must be submitted in the office within the time limit prescribed by the college along with the necessary certificate. Otherwise for non-award of scholarship/concession student will be fully responsible
- 4. If student who have had a break in their education while studying. (e.g. due to failure, illness etc.), those students are required to affix the scholarship form with an affidavit bearing a stamp of the prescribed amount.



5. Failure to fill University Examination form will result in no scholarship and concession and full fee will be charged.

Examinations and Internal Evaluation

- (1) Attendance of students in college is very important.
- (2) Students are evaluated internally through Unit Test, Seminar, Home Assignments, Interview (Viva-voce Test), group discussion, etc. are organized in the class.
- (3) Students who are absent from component tests, seminars and homework will not be awarded internal assessment/assignment marks. Also, Rs 20/- per paper will be levied to student who absent in college examinations.
- (4) Students whose college attendance is less than 75% will not appear for the examination and will not be awarded internal assessment/assignment marks.
- (5) Attendance of students should be at least 75% in each subject in every semester to be eligible to appear in University Examinations.
- (6) Use of illegal route in examination is a cognizable offence. Examinations conducted in a fair environment are the jewel of the college.



National Service Scheme (N.S.S.)

The college has three NSS units with an intake capacity of 250 students. Various social, personality development activities such as cleaning, literacy, de-addiction, small savings promotion, tree plantation and tree conservation, labor reform etc. are implemented through regular and special camps.

Medical Inspection/Test (Ordinance No. 84)

Every student of the college should present himself/herself for medical inspection before the medical officer of the college on such date/s as may be fixed by the Medical officer in consultation with the Principal.

- 1) A student who remains absent in medical inspection/test on the appointed date and time without satisfactory cause, will be liable to pay a fine of Rs 50/- .
- A student who fails to present himself/herself in medical inspection/test on the next appointed date and time without satisfactory cause, should have to pay an additional fine of Rs 25/- .

Physical Education (Ordinance No. 9)

- 1) Sports Director in case of emergency Hon. The permission of the Principal will remain the right to take necessary decisions and it will be binding on the students.
- 2) If there are any complaints of the students in any matter related to sports, they should contact the sports teacher and they are eliminated by exchanging ideas with the committee. Committee regarding this, if necessary, will take the advice of the principal and the decision of the principal will be binding.
- 3) On the recommendation of the Director, the Principal reserves the right to cancel the selection of the respective players or the entire team on the grounds of irregular attendance of the students selected in the team, lack of discipline and lack of specific standards.
- 4) After checking the fitness of the players, they should be admitted to the game as per the recommendation of the Sports Director The principal will have the final right to decide no. Physical Ability Test: Physical ability test of students in second semester under this test is taken. Rs. 50/- on absentee students' fine is levied.



DISCIPLINE AND CODE OF CONDUCT : Rules and Regulations

- 1) All students should observe the rules of discipline and are expected to be of dignified behavior and good character within the college and their social life.
- 2) It is compulsory to wear uniform while coming to college.
- 3) Identity card is mandatory for students to wear inside the college. In case of loss of identity card given at the time of original admission Rs. 50/- another identity card will be issued.
- 4) The students must gather for National Anthem on all working days.
- 5) Use of mobile is strictly prohibited in the college premises.
- 6) Remember alwayscollege campus is covered by CCTV camera.
- 7) The students are expected to maintain strict discipline in and out of the college. Any misconduct with teachers, staff, fellow students and girls in particular, will punish including rustication.
- 8) Students should not wander around the college premises when they have no classes. Loitering in the Corridors and disturbing the classes will invite punishment. strictdisciplinary action will be taken on them.
- 9) Students should use the college property including buildings, furniture, books, fans and equipment, any other property, etc with full care. If student deliberately indulges in any damage of the same, strict action will be taken against him/her and damage will be recovered.
- 10) Students should strictly follow the discipline of the college, they should behave respectfully and politely with all the officials of the institution, college officials, staff, or teachers.
- 11) While representing in other colleges, students should pay careful attention that the image of their college will not be tarnished.
- 12) Do not bring any person who is not related to the college with you while coming to the college.
- 13) Any change in the subject/subjects or faculty will not be allowed with the prior permission of Principal.
- 14) Any change in the local or permanent address of students should be communicated promptly in writing.
- 15) Students Council will be constituted as per the provisions in Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 and directives from the Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur.
- 16) It is expected to see the notices or any instructions daily displayed on the student's notice boards, respective WhatsApp group, personal email, college website, etc.
- 17) Without the prior permission of the Principal, holding meetings and gatherings in the college premises, organizing trips, collecting subscriptions from students, putting up advertisements or leaflets in the premises, giving any information related to the college for publication in newspapers, making written and verbal complaints to university or college management body regarding the college, etc. Strict disciplinary action will be taken.
- The students are not authorized to to form unions, like morcha, boycott of classes, strikes, etc. without prior intimation at least 5 days before to the Principal and without any just or legimate cause or grievance. It will be resulted in rustication of the concerned students.

- 19) The students found involved in the activities which are not in the interest of the college will be expelled without any kind of enquiry. The right of giving TC or expelling the students from the college is reserved with the Principal.
- 20) If any incident of ragging comes to notice of the authority, the concerned student will be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the college, as per the order of Supreme Court SLP(c) No. 24259/2004. Ragging of any kind is strictly prohibited on the campus. Anyone found involved in this activity will be legally prosecuted. As per Government of Maharashtra Resolution (GR) dated 15th May 1999 Ragging' is a cognizable offence.
- 21) If a student is absent continuously for 15 days without permission his/her name will be struck off the register and he will have to pay Rs 50 for readmission.
- 22) Students should use suggestion box for suggestions/complaints/grievances, etc with name.
- 23) An annual festival will be celebrated in memory of Shivprasad Jaiswal, the founder of Trust. Keeping in mind the seriousness of this commemoration, every student should behave with great responsibility and discipline in all the programs organized in the college. All the students should take care that irresponsible behavior in front of guests at the event.
- 24) Bicycles or other two-wheeled vehicles should be kept in an orderly queue at the vehicle parking stand for students. Students should not park their vehicles/bicycles elsewhere in the premises as well as in front of the entrance otherwise fine will be imposed.
- 25) It is mandatory to strictly follow the instructions given by the administration. The Principal will reserves the right to take any kind of disciplinary action.
